ADOPTION OF THE AGENDA OF THE FORTY-SEVENTH REGULAR SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY AND ALLOCATION OF ITEMS (continued)

Request for the inclusion of an additional item submitted by the Russian Federation (A/47/247)

1. The CHAIRMAN invited the Committee to consider the request by the Russian Federation for the inclusion of an item entitled "Mass violations of human rights and freedoms in Latvia and Estonia" (A/47/247). As a result of intensive consultations, it had been proposed that the title of the item should be revised to read "The situation of human rights in Estonia and Latvia". He took it that the Committee wished to revise the title in accordance with the proposal.
2. It was so decided.
3. The Committee decided to recommend that the General Assembly should include the additional item, as revised, in the agenda.
4. The Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item should be allocated to the Third Committee.

Request for the inclusion of an additional item submitted by Nicaragua (A/47/248)

5. The CHAIRMAN invited the Committee to consider the request by Nicaragua for the inclusion of an additional item entitled "International assistance for the rehabilitation and reconstruction of Nicaragua: aftermath of the war and of natural disasters" (A/47/248).
6. The Committee decided to recommend that the General Assembly should include the additional item in the agenda.
7. The Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item should be considered directly in plenary meeting on a priority basis.

Letter from Afghanistan (A/47/661)

8. The CHAIRMAN drew attention to a letter from the Chargé d'affaires a.i. of the Permanent Mission of Afghanistan containing a request that agenda item 141, entitled "Emergency international assistance for the reconstruction

(The Chairman)

of war-stricken Afghanistan", should be considered directly in plenary meeting and not in the Second Committee (A/47/661).

9. The Committee decided, under rule 123 of the rules of procedure, to reconsider the question of the allocation of agenda item 141.

10. The Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that the item should be considered directly in plenary meeting.
