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REPORT OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

I. INTRODUCTION

1. At its 3rd plenary meeting, on 18 September 1992, the General Assembly, on the recommendation of the General Committee, decided to include in the agenda of its forty-seventh session the item entitled "Report of the Economic and Social Council".

2. At the same meeting, the General Assembly decided to allocate to the Third Comittee chapters of the report of the Economic and Social Council $\underline{1}$ / that were considered under the relevant items of the agenda (see A/C.3/47/1).

3. The Third Committee considered item 12 at its 52nd and 60th meetings on 1 and 9 December 1992.

4. For its consideration of the item, the Committee had before it the following documents:

II. CONSIDERATION OF PROPOSALS

A. <u>Organization of work of the Third Committee and draft</u> <u>biennial programme of work of the Third Committee for</u> 1993-1994, contained in document A/C.3/47/L.50

5. At its 60th meeting, on 9 December, the Committee had before it a note by the Secretariat entitled "Organization of work of the Third Committee and draft biennial programme of work of the Committee (A/C.3/47/L.50), which had been orally revised at an informal meeting.

6. At the same meeting, the Committee approved the organization of work and draft biennial programme of work as contained in document A/C.3/47/L.50, as orally revised (see para. 8, draft decision I).

B. <u>Documents relating to the report of</u> the Economic and Social Council

7. At its 60th meeting, on 9 December, on the proposal of the Chairman, the Committee decided to recommend to the General Assembly that it take note of the documents relating to the report of the Economic and Social Council (see para. 8, draft decision II).

III. RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE THIRD COMMITTEE

8. The Third Committee recommends to the General Assembly the adoption of the following draft decisions:

DRAFT DECISION I

Organization of work of the Third Committee and draft biennial programme of work of the Committee for 1993-1994

The General Assembly, pursuant to its resolution 45/170 of 18 December 1990 and 46/140 of 17 December 1991, approves the organization of work of the Third Committee and the biennial programme of work of the Committee for 1993-1994, as contained in annexes I and II to the present decision.

ANNEX I

Organization of work of the Third Committee

A. GUIDELINES CONCERNING TIME-LIMITS OF STATEMENTS

1. In accordance with rule 106 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly and paragraph 22 of decision 34/401 on the rationalization of the procedures and organization of the General Assembly, at the beginning of each session, the Chairman of the Third Committee should propose to the Committee the limitation of the time to be allowed to speakers.

2. Further to General Assembly resolutions 45/175 of 18 December 1990 and 46/140 of 17 December 1991, on the rationalization of the work of the Third Committee, statements made by delegations or on behalf of groups of delegations and by Secretariat officials, unless decided otherwise by the Committee at the beginning of the session, should not exceed 15 minutes. This time-limit will have to be applied with a degree of flexibility towards all speakers. With a view to saving time, all speakers are encouraged to exercise self-discipline, in particular delegations associated with group statements. For practical reasons, group statements are encouraged for the first day of the discussion of an item or sub-item. In this connection, it is important to emphasize the timely distribution of documentation in accordance with the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, in order to enable delegations to inscribe themselves on the list of speakers at an early stage.

B. DRAFT RESOLUTIONS ON REPORTS OF TREATY BODIES AND REPORTS OF THE SECRETARY-GENERAL ON THE STATUS OF THE TREATIES

3. Reports of all treaty bodies will be submitted to the General Assembly in accordance with their respective legislative mandate. Substantive resolutions on those reports should be adopted biennially, in accordance with the programme of work of the Third Committee. Where possible, it is recommended that separate draft resolutions on the status of the treaties should not be submitted but should be incorporated in the draft resolution relating to the report of the treaty body. In alternate years, the Committee should simply take note of the reports unless more substantive action is deemed appropriate.

C. DRAFT PROPOSALS EMANATING FROM SUBSIDIARY ORGANS OF THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL COUNCIL

4. The Economic and Social Council, in transmitting draft proposals to the General Assembly should, to the extent possible, bear in mind the programme of work of the Third Committee.

D. PROGRAMME OF WORK

5. An informal meeting of the Third Committee should be held immediately after the election of the members of its Bureau in order to consider the programme of work of the Committee based on a draft to be prepared by the Secretariat and to consider other organizational aspects relating to the Committee's work, especially the status of documentation.

6. The items allocated to the Third Committee for consideration during the forty-eighth session of the General Assembly should be taken up in the following order:

- Item 2. Elimination of racism and racial discrimination 2/
- Item 3. Right of peoples to self-determination 2/
- <u>Item 4</u>. Social development, including questions relating to the world social situation and to youth, ageing, disabled persons and the family <u>3</u>/
- Item 5. Crime prevention and criminal justice 3/
- Item 6. Advancement of women
- Item 7. International drug control
- <u>Item 8</u>. Report of the United Nations High Commissioner for Refugees, questions relating to refugees, returnees and displaced persons and humanitarian questions
- Item 9. Human rights questions 4/, 5/

 - (b) Human rights questions, including alternative approaches for improving the effective enjoyment of human rights and fundamental freedoms;
