LETTER DATED 7 MARCH 1988 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government, and with reference to the letter from Mr. Tariq Aziz, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs of Iraq, dated 5 March 1988 and issued as document S/19583, I have the honour to inform you that the aggressive and expansionist Iranian régime has fired ground-to-ground missiles at the city of Baghdad as indicated below:

The above missiles struck residential districts of the city of Baghdad, killing and wounding a number of the civilian population, including women and children, and damaging dwellings and private property.
