Addendum

Pursuant to rule 11 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the Secretary-General is submitting the following summary statement.

The list of items of which the Security Council is seized is contained in document S/13737 of 11 January 1980 and S/13737/Add.35 of 10 September 1980.

During the week ending 27 September 1980, the Security Council took action on the following item:

The situation between Iran and Iraq

In a letter dated 26 September 1980 addressed to the President of the Security Council (S/14198), the representatives of Mexico and Norway requested that an urgent meeting of the Security Council be convened to consider the ongoing conflict between Iran and Iraq.

The Security Council considered the item at its 2247th meeting on 26 September 1980. The President, with the consent of the Council, invited the representative of Iraq, at his request, to participate in the discussion without the right to vote.
