Letter dated 16 January 1979 from the Charge d'Affaires a.i. of the
Office of the Permanent Observer of the Palestine Liberation
Organization to the United Nations addressed to the President of
the Security Council

Upon instructions of the Executive Committee of the Palestine Liberation Organization, I should like to draw your attention to the fact that on the night of 15 January, Israel committed another in its series of acts of state terrorism. The target of the Zionist State's latest terrorist act was the refugee camp of Rashidiyeh, which Israeli naval units bombarded with heavy artillery prior to a landing operation. Enemy elements succeeded in reaching the vicinity of the camp -- in the outskirts of which they destroyed a house before being confronted by local camp guards, who forced them to withdraw, leaving behind light arms, rockets and ammunition.

I am instructed to call on you to take immediate and effective measures to put an end to this series of Israeli acts of aggression, which constitute a grave danger to international peace and security.
