According to information received from officials of the Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran, United States warships positioned in the Sea of Oman and the Persian Gulf have created a nuisance for Iranian sea patrolling aircraft on the following dates and locations:

1. On 27 October 1991 at 0944 hours, a United States warship at the position of N2540 and E5442 warned the pilot of an Iranian sea patrolling aircraft, whose position was N2543 and E5358, not to get closer to the warship.

2. On 29 October 1991 at 1150 hours, a United States warship at the position of N2415 and E5852 warned the pilot of an Iranian sea patrolling aircraft, whose position was N2452 and E5832, not to get closer to the warship.

3. On 5 November 1991 at 1110 hours, a United States warship at the position of N2630 and E5645 warned the pilot of an Iranian sea patrolling aircraft, whose position was N2632 and E5640, not to get closer to the warship.

4. On 11 November 1991 at 0845 hours, a United States warship at the position of N2606 and E5246 warned the pilot of an Iranian sea patrolling aircraft, whose position was N2610 and E5306, not to get closer to the warship.

5. On 15 November 1991 at 0942 hours, a United States warship at the position of N2556 and E5342 warned the pilot of an Iranian sea patrolling aircraft, whose position was N2601 and E5314, not to get closer to the warship.

The Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran protests such illegal actions by the Government of the United States.

According to information received from officials of the Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran, on 11 November 1991 a United States warship warned an Iranian civilian passenger Boeing 727 airplane belonging to Iran Air with the registration character of EP-IRH en route to Shiraz Sayri. The passenger plane was flying in the international corridor W25.

This act of warning by a United States warship to a civilian passenger plane of the Islamic Republic of Iran which was flying in an international corridor is a violation of an internationally recognized regulation and is a clear act of aggression against the sovereignty of an independent State.

Therefore, the Government of the Islamic Republic of Iran protests this unjustifiable, illegal, and wilful action of the United States Government which is contrary to the Government's international treaties and insistently demands that these actions be stopped at once. It is evident that the United States Government will be directly held accountable for these unlawful and aggressive measures.

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
