ADMISSION OF NEW MEMBERS TO THE UNITED NATIONS

Letter dated 8 January 1993 from the President of the
Security Council to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to request you to transmit to the resumed forty-seventh session of the General Assembly the following resolution (resolution 801 (1993)) on the admission of the Czech Republic to membership in the United Nations, adopted by the Security Council at its 3158th meeting, on 8 January 1993:

"The Security Council,

"Having examined the application of the Czech Republic for admission to the United Nations, 1/

"Recommends to the General Assembly that the Czech Republic be admitted to membership in the United Nations.

"1/ A/47/851-S/25045."

I would point out that, when adopting the aforementioned resolution, the Security Council decided to have recourse to the provisions of the last paragraph of rule 60 of its provisional rules of procedure in order to submit its recommendation to the resumed forty-seventh session of the General Assembly.

In accordance with rule 60, paragraph 2, of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, I also request you to transmit to the forty-seventh session of the General Assembly, for its information, the verbatim records of the 3156th and 3158th meetings of the Council, at which the application of the Czech Republic was considered.
