NOTE BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

1. The Chairman of the Security Council Commission established under resolution 446 (1979) to examine the situation relating to settlements in the Arab territories occupied since 1967, including Jerusalem, has, on behalf of the Commission, informed me that in accordance with the decision taken by the Security Council to maintain its original composition, the Commission has resumed its work. It will, however, be difficult for the Commission to report to the Council before 1 September 1980 as called for in paragraph 9 of resolution 465 (1980). Accordingly, the Chairman of the Commission has requested an extension of the date of submission of its report until 25 November 1980.

2. Following informal consultations on the matter, it has been found that no member of the Security Council has any objection to the Commission's request and the Chairman of the Commission has been so informed.
