NOTE VERBALE DATED 27 AUGUST 1980 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF DENMARK TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

The Permanent Representative of Denmark to the United Nations presents his compliments to the Secretary-General of the United Nations and has the honour to refer to the Secretary-General's note PO 230/SOAF (2-2-3-1) of 2 July 1980, requesting information on the measures taken by the Danish Government in accordance with the provisions of Security Council resolutions 418 (1977) and 473 (1980) concerning the arms embargo against South Africa.

In reply the Permanent Representative of Denmark has the honour to refer to his note of 27 February 1978, forwarding the text of a Royal Decree on certain measures against South Africa which entered into force on 10 February 1978. The note and the Royal Decree were circulated as Security Council document S/12510/Add.1 of 1 March 1978. This Decree constitutes the national legislation enacted by the Danish Government in order to ensure strict and full compliance with resolution 418 (1977).

The Permanent Representative of Denmark has the honour to request that this note be circulated as a document of the Security Council.
