NOTE BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE SECURITY COUNCIL

1. The Chairman of the Security Council Committee established by resolution 421 (1977) concerning the question of South Africa has informed me that the Committee is currently engaged in the task of finalizing its report to the Security Council. It will be difficult for the Committee, however, to report to the Security Council by 15 September 1980, as called for in paragraph 11 of resolution 473 (1980). Accordingly, the Chairman of the Committee has requested an extension of the date of submission of its report until 19 September 1980.

2. Following informal consultations on the matter, it has been found that no member of the Security Council has any objection to the Committee's request and the Chairman of the Committee has been so informed.
