LETTER DATED 5 FEBRUARY 1993 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to bring to your attention the following instances of violations by Iraq of the terms of the cease-fire between the two countries.

- 1. On 23 October 1992, at 0835-1000 hours, nine Iraqi forces were observed constructing a bunker at the GCs of 04-68 and 08-69 on the map of Mehran in NML.
- 2. On 24 October 1992, at 0320 hours, three or four Iraqi forces crossing the NML at the GCs of 39-60, north of border pillar 22/11 and south of border pillar 22/12, approached the Iranian sentry post. They fled the area when confronted with the timely reaction of Iranian forces.
- 3. On 27 October 1992, a number of Iraqi forces constructed a checkpoint at a distance of one kilometre from Hemad-Shahab sentry post at the GCs of 065-935 on the map of Meimeh river in NML south of border pillar 23.
- 4. On 2 November 1992, at 0825 hours, a number of Iraqi forces were observed constructing a bunker at the GCs of 017-940 on the map of Meimeh river in NML south-west of border pillar 24/2.
- 5. On 2 November 1992, at 1255 hours, the Iraqi forces aboard a Toyota and a white patrol vehicle entered the NML in the Hemad-Shahab sentry post at the GCs of 065-935 on the map of Meimeh river. They left the area after a 10-minute stop and check on the group bunkers at the GCs of 049-899.

6. On 5 November 1992, at 0830 hours, two Iraqi forces were seen conducting observation at the GCs of 421-634 on the map of Naft-Shahr in NML.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter were circulated as a document of the Security Council.
