LETTER DATED 5 FEBRUARY 1993 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF THE ISLAMIC REPUBLIC OF IRAN TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED
TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

Upon instructions from my Government, I have the honour to bring to your attention the following instances of violations by Iraq of the terms of the cease-fire between the two countries.

1. On 9 November 1992, at 1500 hours, four Iraqi forces were observed restoring a bunker at the geographic coordinates of 70-21 on the map of Chazabeh in no man's land north-west of border pillar 15 and south-west of border pillar 16.
2. On 14 November 1992, at 1300 hours, 12 Iraqi forces were observed constructing a bunker at the geographic coordinates of 434-027 on the map of Khosravi, in no man's land west of border pillar 53/1.
3. On 5 December 1992, at 1200 hours, seven Iraqi forces were observed constructing a bunker at the geographic coordinates of 880-128 on the map of Halaleh in no man's land around border pillar 53/3.
4. On 17 December 1992, at 1455 hours, 71 Iraqi Kurds were observed collecting empty shells and scrap metal at the geographic coordinates of 681-229 and the geographic coordinates of 675-251 on the map of Ghasr-e-Shirin, in no man's land between border pillar 60 and 60/3. When confronted with the reaction of the Iranian forces they fled the area.

It would be highly appreciated if this letter was circulated as a document of the Security Council.
