ANNEX

Letter dated 4 April 1988 from the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Iraq addressed to the Secretary-General

I have the honour to inform you that it has been ascertained that, on 30 and 31 March 1988, the artillery and aircraft of the criminal Iranian régime bombarded Iraqi troops in the Halabjah sector with chemical agents. This savage bombardment caused extensive injury to 88 Iraqi soldiers, who are currently receiving care at a hospital in Baghdad.

We have made it clear on many occasions that the Iranian régime, while committing criminal acts which are in violation of the principles of international humanitarian law, makes spurious complaints about the non-implementation of those principles in order to cover up its crimes and divert attention from its policy of prolongation of the war, aggression and expansion.

The Iraqi Government requests you to send a mission to Baghdad immediately in order to examine the wounded and obtain detailed information about the attack.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
