LETTER DATED 10 APRIL 1988 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government and further to our repeated letters, the most recent being that contained in document S/19752, concerning the Iranian régime's continuing bombardment of purely residential centres in Iraq, I have the honour to inform you that the forces of that régime carried out acts of aggression from 1730 hours on 6 April 1988 until 0700 hours on 7 April 1988, from 0700 hours until 1730 hours on 7 April 1988, from 1730 hours on 7 April 1988 until 0700 hours on 8 April 1988, from 1730 hours on 8 April 1988 until 0700 hours on 9 April 1988, from 0700 hours until 1730 hours on 9 April 1988, from 1730 hours on 9 April 1988 until 0700 hours on 10 April 1988 and from 0700 hours until 1730 hours on 10 April 1988, as detailed in the annex to this letter.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter and its annex circulated as a document of the Security Council.
