LETTER DATED 6 OCTOBER 1980 FROM THE MINISTER OF FOREIGN  
AFFAIRS OF SIERRA LEONE ADDRESSED TO THE PRESIDENT OF  
THE SECURITY COUNCIL

Further to the letter of 23 September 1980, to your predecessor, Ambassador Slim of Tunisia, from the Permanent Representative of Sierra Leone on behalf of the African Group, requesting a Security Council meeting to consider the situation in South Africa (S/14189), and further to our discussion this morning, I take this opportunity to confirm that it is the wish of the African Group that the Council remain seized of this matter and that, after consultation, an appropriate date will be suggested as the date for its consideration.
