Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 47th meeting, on 17 December 1992, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/47/73) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/47/L.34. The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
- 2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (P/C.5/47/SR.47).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/47/L.34 an additional appropriation of \$155,200 would be required under section 2 (Peace-keeping operations and special missions) of the programme budget for the biennium 1992-1993 on the understanding that these requirements should be dealt with

under the provisions of paragraph 11 of annex I to General Assembly resolution 41/213 of 19 December 1986 and should thus be treated outside the procedure related to the contingency fund. Furthermore, an additional appropriation of \$40,100 would be required under section 36 (Staff assessment), offset by the same amount under income section 1 (Income from staff assessment).
