Report of the Fifth Committee

1. At its 47th meeting, on 17 December 1992, the Fifth Committee, pursuant to rule 153 of the rules of procedure of the General Assembly, considered the statement by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/47/73) on the programme budget implications of draft resolution A/47/L.34. The related report of the Advisory Committee on Administrative and Budgetary Questions was presented orally by its Chairman.
2. Statements and comments made in the course of the Committee's consideration of this item are reflected in the relevant summary record (A/C.5/47/SR.47).

DECISION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

3. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to inform the General Assembly that, should it adopt draft resolution A/47/L.34 an additional appropriation of \$155,200 would be required under section 2 (Peace-keeping operations and special missions) of the programme budget for the biennium 1992-1993 on the understanding that these requirements should be dealt with

under the provisions of paragraph 11 of annex I to General Assembly resolution 41/213 of 19 December 1986 and should thus be treated outside the procedure related to the contingency fund. Furthermore, an additional appropriation of \$40,100 would be required under section 36 (Staff assessment), offset by the same amount under income section 1 (Income from staff assessment).
