LETTER DATED 18 APRIL 1988 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF
IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government and with reference to the letter dated 14 March 1988 addressed to you by Mr. Tariq Aziz, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Iraq, as well as my letters dated 16 March, 21 March and 11 April 1988, I have the honour to inform you that the expansionist Iranian régime fired two surface-to-surface missiles at the city of Baghdad at 2258 hours on 14 April 1988 and at 1450 hours on 16 April 1988.

The two missiles struck residential districts in Baghdad, killing or wounding members of the civilian population, including some women and children, and destroying or damaging a number of houses, shops and other private property.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter distributed as a document of the Security Council.
