Note by the Secretary-General

Addendum

1. Further to the notification submitted to the General Assembly on 15 September 1980 (A/35/453), the Secretary-General has the honour to notify the Assembly of an additional matter relative to the maintenance of international peace and security which is being dealt with by the Security Council, and of matters with which the Council has ceased to deal.
2. An additional matter which has been taken under consideration by the Security Council since the notification to the General Assembly on 15 September is the item entitled "The situation between Iran and Iraq".
3. During this period, following consultations among the members of the Security Council, it was agreed that the following items would be removed from the list:
  - (a) Question concerning the situation in Southern Rhodesia (A/35/453, para. 2, item 7);
  - (b) Request by Mozambique under Article 50 of the Charter of the United Nations in relation to the situation which has arisen as a result of its decision to impose sanctions against Southern Rhodesia in full implementation of the relevant decisions of the Security Council (A/35/453, para. 3, item 73);
  - (c) Complaint of the Government of Botswana against the illegal régime in Southern Rhodesia concerning violations of its territorial sovereignty, as contained in the letter dated 22 December 1976 from the Permanent Representative of Botswana to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council (A/35/453, para. 3, item 80);
  - (d) Complaint by Mozambique (A/35/453, para. 3, item 82).
