Letter dated 15 September 1994 from the President of the Economic and Social Council addressed to the President of the General Assembly

I wish to bring to your attention a decision of the Economic and Social Council for early consideration by the General Assembly. $\underline{1}/$

During its annual session held in Geneva from 6 to 16 June 1994, the Executive Board of the United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) and of the United Nations Population Fund (UNFPA) adopted the attached decision 94/21 on the commemoration of the twenty-fifth anniversary of the operations of the United Nations Population Fund.

In paragraph 1 of decision 94/21, the Executive Board "recommends to the General Assembly that it allocate a plenary meeting during its forty-ninth session (1994) to the commemoration of the twenty-fifth anniversary of the operations of the United Nations Population Fund". This decision was endorsed by the Economic and Social Council in its decision 1994/285 of 26 July 1994.
