LETTER DATED 13 SEPTEMBER 1994 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE
OF IRAQ TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government and further to my letter of 5 September 1994 referring to the letter dated 14 July 1994 from the Permanent Representative of the Islamic Republic of Iran (S/1994/830) issued on 17 July 1994, which contained allegations of violations by Iraq of the terms of the cease-fire between the two countries during the period from 1 to 30 April 1994, I have the honour to inform you that the Government of the Republic of Iraq denies the allegations made in the letter, which are merely intended to create a climate of tension and which reflect tendencies that cast doubt on the good faith of the Iranian side, to which we wish to draw attention.

The Government of the Republic of Iraq assures you of its compliance with the cease-fire and the terms of the area of separation between the two countries and expresses the hope that Iran will abide by those terms in the same spirit and refrain from repeating such allegations.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
