Appointment of six members of the Committee on Contributions

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Carl C. PEDERSEN (Canada)

- 1. At its 13th meeting, on 10 October 1980, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/35/212) concerning the vacancies which will occur in the Committee on Contributions as a result of the expiration on 31 December 1980 of the terms of office of six of its members.
- 2. The Fifth Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/35/24) containing the names of seven persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment to the Committee on Contributions. During the meeting it was announced that the nomination of one of the candidates had been withdrawn.
- 3. The Fifth Committee then decided, without a vote, to recommend Mr. Helio de Burgos-Cabal (Brazil), Mr. Leoncio Fernández Maroto (Spain), Mr. Lance Joseph (Australia), Mr. Japhet G. Kiti (Kenya), Mr. Rachid Lahlou (Morocco) and Mr. Atilio M. Molteni (Argentina) to the General Assembly for appointment as members of the Committee on Contributions for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 1981.
