Appointment of a member of the Board of Auditors

Report of the Fifth Committee

Rapporteur: Mr. Carl C. PEDERSEN (Canada)

1. At its 13th meeting, on 10 October 1980, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/35/213) concerning the vacancy in the membership of the Board of Auditors which will occur as a result of the expiration of the term of office of one of its members on 30 June 1981.
2. The Fifth Committee also had before it notes by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/35/20 and Add.1) containing the names of the Comptroller and Auditor-General of Bangladesh and the Chairman of the Commission on Audit of the Philippines for appointment to the Board of Auditors. During the meeting it was announced that the nomination of the Chairman of the Commission on Audit of the Philippines had been withdrawn.
3. The Fifth Committee then decided, without a vote, to recommend the Comptroller and Auditor-General of Bangladesh for appointment as a member of the Board of Auditors for a three-year term beginning on 1 July 1981.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

4. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly should appoint the Comptroller and Auditor-General of Bangladesh as a member of the Board of Auditors for a three-year term beginning on 1 July 1981.
