APPOINTMENTS TO FILL VACANCIES IN SUBSIDIARY ORGANS AND OTHER APPOINTMENTS

Confirmation of the appointment of three members of the Investments Committee

Report of the Fifth Committee

- 1. At its 13th meeting, on 10 October 1980, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/35/214) concerning the vacancies arising on the Investments Committee as a result of the expiration of the terms of office, on 31 December 1980, of three of its members. The Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/35/15), in which, in accordance with the provisions of article 20 of the regulations of the United Nations Joint Staff Pension Fund, the Secretary-General recommended for confirmation by the General Assembly the reappointment of Mr. David Montagu and Mr. Yves Oltramare and the appointment of Mr. Emmanuel Noi Omaboe (also known as Nana Wereko Ampen II) for three-year terms beginning on 1 January 1981, as well as the appointment of Mr. George Johnston for a one-year term beginning on 1 January 1981 to replace Mr. R. Manning Brown, Jr. who had indicated that he would not be able to complete his term of office.
- 2. The Fifth Committee decided, without a vote, to recommend to the General Assembly that it should confirm the appointments of Mr. David Montagu, Mr. Yves Oltramare and Mr. Emmanuel Noi Omaboe for three-year terms beginning on 1 January 1981, and Mr. George Johnston for a one-year term beginning on 1 January 1981.

RECOMMENDATION OF THE FIFTH COMMITTEE

- 3. The Fifth Committee recommends that the General Assembly should:
- (a) Confirm the appointment by the Secretary-General of the following persons as members of the Investments Committee for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 1981:
 - Mr. David Montagu
 - Mr. Yves Oltramare
 - Mr. Emmanuel Noi Omaboe
- (b) Confirm the appointment by the Secretary-General of the following person as a member of the Investments Committee for a one-year term beginning on 1 January 1981:
 - Mr. George Johnston
