Appointment of two members of the United Nations
Administrative Tribunal

Report of the Fifth Committee (Part II)

Rapporteur: Mr. Carl C. PEDERSEN (Canada)

1. At its 13th meeting, on 10 October 1980, the Fifth Committee considered a note by the Secretary-General (A/35/215) concerning the vacancies in the membership of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal which will occur as a result of expiration of the terms of office of two members on 31 December 1980.
2. The Fifth Committee also had before it a note by the Secretary-General (A/C.5/35/14) containing the names of two persons nominated by their respective Governments for appointment to the United Nations Administrative Tribunal.
3. The Fifth Committee then decided, without a vote, to recommend Mr. Arnold Wilfred Geoffrey Kean (United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland) and Mr. Herbert Reis (United States of America) to the General Assembly for appointment as members of the United Nations Administrative Tribunal for a three-year term beginning on 1 January 1981.
