Letter dated 3 June 1994 from the President of Bosnia
and Herzegovina addressed to the Secretary-General

I was unpleasantly surprised to hear that the United Nations Protection Force (UNPROFOR) intends to permit a liaison officer from Karadžić party to work in cargo at the Tuzla airport. This unilateral decision by UNPROFOR is against clear demands we presented earlier to your Special Representative, and constitutes an open violation of the legal rights of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina. This decision leaves the impression that UNPROFOR is rewarding the aggressors for their constant assaults against the safe area of Tuzla.

It will be recalled that the airport is completely within territory controlled by the Government of the Republic of Bosnia and Herzegovina and that it was handed over to UNPROFOR use prior to the signing of the agreement.

I again express our strong opposition to the presence of any member of the Serb aggressor party at the Tuzla airport.
