JOINT COMMUNIQUE ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF GUYANA AND

THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA

The Government of the Republic of Guyana and the Government of the Republic of South Africa;

Wishing to initiate bonds of friendship and cooperation between their two countries in the mutual interest of their peoples, based on the principles of the United Nations Charter and International Law, particularly international peace and security, equality among States, respect for independence, national sovereignty, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of States;

Have decided to establish diplomatic relations, at ambassadorial level, between the two countries in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 18 April 1961.

This Joint Communique shall enter into force on the day of signature thereof.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the undersigned, being duly authorised thereto, have signed and sealed this Joint Communique, in duplicate.

Done at New York on this 4th day of November 1994.
