#### PROTOCOL

### ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA and the REPUBLIC OF GUYANA

The Republic of Namibia and the Republic of Guyana, guided by mutual willingness to develop relations of friendship and cooperation between the two countries in political, trade, economic and other fields, have decided to establish diplomatic relations as of the date of signing of this Protocol in accordance with the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations signed on April 18, 1961.

These two sides have reached an agreement to develop their relations on the basis of principles of equality of states, mutual respect, self-determination, independence and sovereignty, territorial integrity and non-interference into internal affairs of each other in accordance with the United Nations Charter.

Both sides are convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations between the **REPUBLIC OF NAMIBIA** and the **REPUBLIC OF GUYANA** corresponds to the interest of the two states, is not directed against any other country and will facilitate strengthening of international cooperation and universal peace.
