**JOINT COMMUNIQUE
CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF
DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN
THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF INDONESIA
AND THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SOUTH AFRICA**

The Government of the Republic of Indonesia and the Government of the Republic of South Africa:

Desirous to promote and strengthen the ties of friendship and cooperation between their countries and peoples on the basis of equality, mutual respect for each other's sovereignty, independence and territorial integrity as well as non-interference in the internal affairs of each other;

Guided by the Principles and Purposes of the Charter of the United Nations, the Non-Aligned Movement as well as the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 1961;

HAVE DECIDED

- 1. To establish diplomatic relations between the Republic of Indonesia and the Republic of South Africa at ambassadorial level as of the date of the signing of this Communique;**
- 2. The accreditation of their respective ambassadors will be arranged on a date convenient for both parties.**
