Protocol
on the establishment of diplomatic relations
between the Republic of Lithuania
and the Republic of Mozambique

The Republic of Lithuania and the Republic of Mozambique, guided by mutual desire to develop fraternal ties of friendship and cooperation between the two States in political, trade, economic and other fields, have decided to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level as of the date of the signing of this Protocol, on the basis of the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations, of 18 April 1961.


The relations between the two States will be based on the principles of sovereign equality among states, mutual respect, self-determination, independence, territorial integrity and non-interference in the internal affairs of each other, in accordance with the purposes and principles of the Charter of the United Nations.

The Republic of Lithuania and the Republic of Mozambique are fully convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations between them corresponds to the interests of the two States and will further strengthen international peace and security.


In witness whereof, the undersigned Representatives, duly authorized by their respective Governments, have signed this Protocol in three originals, in English, Lithuanian and Portuguese languages, all texts being equally authentic.
