The Government of Saint Lucia and the Government of the Republic of Cyprus, desirous of developing and strengthening their relations in the interest of peace and cooperation among peoples, and on the basis of mutual respect for independence, sovereignty and territorial integrity, as well as on the principles of noninterference in the internal affairs of any country, on the nonuse of force in international relations, of the pacific settlement of disputes and of the other principles enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations, have agreed to establish Diplomatic Relations at Ambassadorial Level, on a non-residential basis as from July 24, 1980.

The two Governments express their conviction that establishment of diplomatic relations will contribute to promoting the relations between their peoples and countries in terms of their mutual interest, for the maintenance of peace and international co-operation.

Signed in New York on the 24th day of July, 1980.
