
JOINT COMMUNIQUÉ

*On the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations between
the Republic of the Philippines and the Kingdom of Swaziland*

The Government of the Republic of the Philippines and the Government of the Kingdom of Swaziland, animated by a common desire of developing friendly and cooperative relations between the two countries on the basis of the principles of mutual respect for each other's independence, sovereignty and territorial integrity, as well as mutual cooperation and benefit, have decided to establish diplomatic relations at ambassadorial level effective on the date of signing of this Joint Communiqué and to exchange non-resident ambassadors as their respective representatives at a time convenient to both Governments.
