JOINT COMMUNIQUE

on the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations
between the Republic of the Marshall Islands and
the Republic of Finland

The Republic of Marshall Islands and the Republic of Finland take great pleasure in announcing their mutual recognition and establishment of diplomatic relations.

It is the intention of both Governments to complete the timely appointment of Ambassadors to each other's country. This will, initially, be on a Non-Resident basis, with Resident Ambassadors being appointed as and when circumstances permit.

Both Governments look forward to the further development of close and friendly relations between them and their peoples.
