### JOINT DECLARATION

# on the Establishment of Diplomatic Relations between the Kingdom of Swaziland and the Republic of Iceland

The Kingdom of Swaziland and the Republic of Iceland, convinced that the best way to strengthen peace and international security is through understanding, cooperation and friendly relations between nations, take great pleasure in announcing their mutual recognition and the establishment of diplomatic relations.

It is the view of both Governments that the mutual relations between the two States shall be carried out in the first instance through their Permanent Representatives to the United Nations.

Both Governments look forward to the further development of close and friendly relations between them and their peoples.
