Excellency,

We have the honour to inform Your Excellency that on 9 November 1993, the Governments of the Republic of Malawi and the Republic of Angola have issued simultaneously a Joint Communique concerning the establishment of diplomatic relations between our two countries, the text of which is as follows:

The Governments of the Republic of Malawi and the Republic of Angola have agreed to establish bonds of friendship and cooperation on the basis of the principles of mutual respect of national sovereignty, territorial integrity, non-interference in the internal affairs of each other and equal rights.


Desiring to obtain this objective, the two Governments have decided to establish formal diplomatic relations.


The Governments of both countries express the hope that the establishment of diplomatic relations will lead to the development of mutually beneficial cooperation.

Excellency, we would request you to transmit this communication to States Members of the United Nations, and we take this opportunity to renew to you the assurances of our highest consideration.
