Excellency,

We have the honour to inform you that on 10 November 1993, the Governments of the Republic of Angola and the Republic of Macedonia have issued simultaneously a Joint Communiqué concerning the establishment of diplomatic relations between our two countries, the text of which is as follows:

PROTOCOL

**On the establishment of diplomatic relations between the Republic of
Angola and the Republic of Macedonia**

The Republic of Angola and the Republic of Macedonia,

Guided by the mutual willingness to develop relations of friendship and cooperation in the political, economic, cultural, humanitarian and other fields,


Having the intention of developing these relations on the basis of the purposes and norms of the Charter of the United Nations and International Law,

Have agreed to establish diplomatic relations at the Ambassadorial level as of the date of the signing of this Protocol, based on the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations of 1961.


The Republic of Angola and the Republic of Macedonia are convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations corresponds to the national interests of both States, and will contribute to the consolidation of cooperation and peace in the world.

Done in the City of New York, on 10 November 1993, in English, Portuguese, and Macedonian, all having the same validity.
