Excellency,



JOINT ANNOUNCEMENT

ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE UNION OF MYANMAR AND THE GOVERNMENT OF HIS MAJESTY THE SULTAN AND YANG DI-PERTUAN OF BRUNEI DARUSSALAM

The Government of the Union of Myanmar and the Government of His Majesty the Sultan And Yang Di-Pertuan of Brunei Darussalam, in conformity with the interest and desire of the two peoples, have decided to establish diplomatic relations between the two countries at the ambassadorial level as from 21 September 1993.

The two Governments have agreed to develop friendly relations and cooperation between the two countries on the basis of the Five Principles of Peaceful Co-existence and the Principles enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations.
