

## Letter dated 24 May 2018 from the Permanent Representative of the Netherlands to the United Nations addressed to the President of the Security Council

I am writing you, also on behalf of the Permanent Representatives of Australia, Belgium, Malaysia and Ukraine to the United Nations, in your capacity as President of the Security Council for the month of May.

With reference to Security Council resolution 2166 (2014) and my previous letters to the Council on 1 and 28 August, 9 September and 16 December 2014, 20 July and 13 October 2015, 28 September 2016 and 5 July 2017, we have the honour to inform you that, on 24 May 2018, the joint investigation team conducting the independent criminal investigation into the downing of Malaysia Airlines flight MH17 over eastern Ukraine on 17 July 2014 presented further findings.

The joint investigation team comprises the investigative authorities of Australia, Belgium, Malaysia, the Netherlands and Ukraine. It is conducting the international criminal investigation that was called for in resolution 2166 (2014). The joint investigation team operates fully independently.

The independent criminal investigation by the joint investigation team is ongoing. We recall that the Security Council, in its resolution 2166 (2014), demanded that "all States cooperate fully with efforts to establish accountability".

The Kingdom of the Netherlands, Australia, the Kingdom of Belgium, Malaysia and Ukraine remain fully committed to holding those responsible for the downing of flight MH17 to account. There must be justice for the families and loved ones of the victims.

I would be grateful if you would have the present letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
