
Excellency,



JOINT COMMUNIQUE
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN THE KINGDOM OF MOROCCO AND
THE REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA

The Kingdom of Morocco and the Republic of Moldova, desiring to develop and strengthen relations of friendship and cooperation between their two countries, have decided to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level as of the date of signature of this joint communiqué, in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on diplomatic relations dated 18 April 1961 and on the basis of the principles enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations.

Done at New York, on October 8th, 1992
in two originals in Arabic, Romanian and English;
all texts being equally authentic.
