We kindly request your Excellency to circulate this Protocol to the member states of the United Nations for their information.



PROTOCOL
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN THE KINGDOM OF MOROCCO AND
TURKMENISTAN

The Kingdom of Morocco and Turkmenistan, desiring to develop and strengthen relations of friendship and cooperation between their two countries, have decided to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level as of the date of signature of this Protocol, in accordance with the provisions of the Vienna Convention on diplomatic relations dated 18 April 1961 and on the basis of the principles enshrined in the Charter of the United Nations.

Done at New York, on September 25th, 1992.
In two copies in Arabic and Turkmen;
both texts being equally authentic.
