
Excellency,

Therefore, we kindly request Your Excellency to have the enclosed English text of the Joint Communique distributed as a United Nations document.



JOINT COMMUNIQUE
CONCERNING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC
RELATIONS BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF THE REPUBLIC


Have decided to establish diplomatic relations at ambassadorial level as of the date of signing of this Joint Communique.


