Excellency,


We have the honour to inform you that on 30 March 1981, the Sultanate of Oman and the Government of the Gabonese Republic have issued simultaneously a joint communique concerning the establishment of diplomatic relations between the two Countries, the text of which is as follows:

Being desirous of promoting cooperation and friendship between the two countries, the Governments of the Sultanate of Oman and the Gabonese Republic have agreed to establish diplomatic relations at Ambassadorial level.

We kindly request Your Excellency to transmit this communication to the States Members of the United Nations and we take this opportunity to renew to you the assurances of our highest consideration.
