We have the honour to present our compliments to you and to request your kind assistance in having the following text of the joint communique on the establishment of diplomatic relations between the Government of the Mongolian People's Republic and the Government of the Republic of Seychelles, which is published simultaneously today by the two Governments, circulated as a United Nations document:

"The Government of the Mongolian People's Republic and the Government of the Republic of Seychelles, desirous of further strengthening and developing relations of friendship and co-operation between their respective countries and peoples on the basis of mutual respect for sovereign equality, have decided to establish diplomatic relations at ambassadorial level as of August 20, 1981."

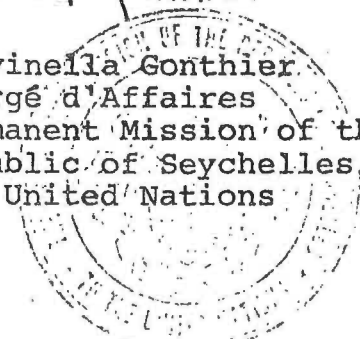
