## THE DANGEROUS DRUGS (APPLICATION) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1951

IN EXERCISE OF the powers conferred upon him by the above-mentioned Ordinance, His Excellency the Acting Governor in Council has been pleased to make the following Order -

1. This Order may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Application) (Amendment) Order, 1951, and shall be read as one with the Dangerous Drugs (Application) Order, 1950 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Order).

2. The Schedule to the principal Order is hereby amended by the addition thereto of the following drugs -

substance containing any proportion of dihydrocodeine.

"Dihydrocodeine, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other

Acetyldihydrocodeine, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of acetyldihydrocodeine.

4-Propionoxy-4-phenyl-1-methyl-3-ethylpiperidine, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of 4-propionoxy-4-phenyl-1-methyl-3-ethylpiperidine.

3-Hydroxy-N-methylmorphinan, its salts and any preparation, admixture, extract or other substance containing any proportion of 3-hydroxy-N-methylmorphinan.
