P R O T O C O L
ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS
BETWEEN THE REPUBLIC OF CYPRUS AND THE REPUBLIC OF MOLDOVA

The Republic of Moldova and the Republic of Cyprus guided by mutual willingness to develop relations of friendship and cooperation between the two countries in political, trade, economic and other fields have decided to establish diplomatic relations as of the date of signing of This Protocol and to exchange diplomatic missions at the level of Embassies.

The two Sides have reached an agreement to develop their relations on the basis of principles of equality of states, mutual respect, self-determination, independence and sovereignty, territorial integrity and non interference into internal affairs of each other in accordance with the UN Charter.

Both Sides are convinced that the establishment of diplomatic relations between the Republic of Moldova and the Republic of Cyprus corresponds to the interests of the Two States, is not directed against any other country and will facilitate strengthening of international cooperation and universal peace.

Both Sides have agreed to base their diplomatic relations on the Vienna Convention on Diplomatic Relations, signed on April 18, 1961.

For this authorized representatives of the Republic of Moldova and the Republic of Cyprus have signed this Protocol in duplicate, in the Moldovian and English languages, both texts being equally authentic.

Done at Moscow on " 21 " February 1992.
