Note by the Secretary-General

1. The Commission on Human Rights, in its resolution 1994/54 of 4 March 1994, on the composition of the staff of the Centre for Human Rights, requested the Secretary-General to present to the Fifth Committee of the General Assembly at its forty-ninth session, through the Economic and Social Council, a report on the current geographical distribution of posts in the staff of the Centre for Human Rights. The present report is submitted pursuant to that request. The current geographical distribution of the Professional posts of the Centre for Human Rights is contained in the annex of this report.
2. It is noted that this is an interim report. A final report will be submitted to the forty-ninth session of the General Assembly.
