AN ORDINANCE

TO AMEND THE DANGEROUS DRUGS ORDINANCE, 1948.

[27th October, 1949]

BE it enacted by the High Commissioner as follows:

Short Title.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Dangerous Drugs (Amendment) Ordinance, 1949.

Amendment of section 15 of Ordinance No. 6 of 1948.

2. Sub-section (2) of section 15 of the Dangerous Drugs Ordinance, 1948, (hereinafter referred to as the principal Ordinance) is amended by the deletion of the word "cause" in paragraph (a) and by the substitution therefor of the word "course".

Amendment of section 39.

3. Sub-section (1) of section 39 of the principal Ordinance is amended by the insertion in paragraph (a) immediately after the words "to comply with" of the words "any of the provisions of this Ordinance or".
