- Consideration would need to be given to the timing of UNCTAD IX. It is recalled that UNCTAD VIII was originally scheduled to be held in the Summer of 1991, but practical problems regarding the hosting of the Conference resulted in its being held in February 1992. Rule 1 of the rules of procedure of the Conference provides: "The United Nations Conference on Trade and Development...shall normally meet at intervals of not more than four years." The present paper is based on the assumption, as suggested by some delegations, that UNCTAD IX would take place in February/March 1996, i.e. four years after UNCTAD VIII was actually held.
