Official communiqué of the 8286th (closed) meeting of the Security Council

Held in private at Headquarters, New York, on Thursday, 14 June 2018, at 10.20 a.m.

In accordance with rule 55 of the provisional rules of procedure of the Security Council, the following communiqué was issued through the Secretary-General in place of a verbatim record:

"On 14 June 2018, the Security Council, pursuant to annex II, sections A and B of resolution 1353 (2001), held its 8286th meeting in private with the troop- and police-contributing countries to the United Nations Disengagement Observer Force.

"The President invited Lieutenant General Carlos Humberto Loitey, Military Adviser for Peacekeeping Operations, to participate in the meeting in accordance with rule 39 of the Council's provisional rules of procedure.

"The Security Council and the troop- and police-contributing countries heard a briefing by Lieutenant General Loitey.

"Members of the Council, Lieutenant General Loitey and representatives of participating contributing countries had an exchange of views."
