LETTER DATED 15 SEPTEMBER 1994 FROM THE PERMANENT REPRESENTATIVE OF KUWAIT TO THE UNITED NATIONS ADDRESSED TO THE SECRETARY-GENERAL

On instructions from my Government and with reference to the letter dated 7 September 1994 addressed to you by the representative of the Iraqi regime (S/1994/1032), I should like to state that this matter has absolutely no basis in fact and that the competent authorities in Kuwait have no information regarding the two Iraqi boys whose names are given in the above-mentioned document.

Furthermore, we should like to state that no Kuwaiti police patrol operates behind the earthen embankment near the boundary line between Kuwait and Iraq except with a United Nations Iraq-Kuwait Observation Mission (UNIKOM) patrol as escort and with the prior approval of the UNIKOM Command for such patrol activities.

I should be grateful if you would have this letter circulated as a document of the Security Council.
